INTRODUCTION:

Chevron Nigeria Limited invites interested and prequalified companies for this tender opportunity for the Provision of one (1) Bombardier Dash 8 - Q400 fixed wing aircraft Services to support NNPC/CNL Joint Venture Operations.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The service to be provided includes and not limited:

- Provision of Dash 8 Q400 fixed wing aircraft Services for the transport of Company and Contractor personnel and materials
- The Provision and Operation of the Dash 8 Q400 fixed wing aircraft, required crew and maintenance support in line with Chevron Aviation Standards requirements.
- Operation of the Dash 8 aircraft from the contractor's owned and operated passenger handling facility at Murtala Muhammed Airport, Lagos, or an alternative facility acceptable solely at Company's discretion to locations required by the Company
- In addition, daily transportation services from Lagos to Escravos and Warri, minimum of six (6) days a week.
- The estimated number of flying hours per month is 100
- Required number of seats is for 70 passengers
- Compliance with all Chevron Aviation Standards requirements for aviation equipment, personnel experience and safety management requirements for operators.

To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested bidders are required to be pre-qualified and 'live' in the Product Group 3.08.03 (Air Transport Services of Passengers and Freight) in NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) database. All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in this category by the bid close date will receive Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT).

- E. To be eligible, all interested bidders must comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.

NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS:

Chevron Nigeria Limited is committed to the development of the Nigerian Oil and Gas business in observance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act 2010 (NOGICD Act) enacted by the Federal Government of Nigeria in April 2010.

Pursuant to enactment of the NOGICD Act, the minimum Nigerian Content in any project, service or product specification to be executed in the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry shall be consistent with the level set in the schedule of the Act and any other target as may be directed by the Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board (NCDMB).

Contractors shall comply with the provisions of the NOGICD Act and all applicable regulations. Bidders that do not meet the Nigerian Content criterion will not be allowed to participate in the next Tender Stage

The following are the Nigerian Content requirements bidders are expected to comply with in their technical bid submission.

A. Tenderer shall demonstrate at least 50% ownership of the Dash 8 - Q400 fixed wing aircraft.

- B. Tenderer shall demonstrate registration with umbrella and/or trade professional bodies Nigerian airline Operators.
- C. Tenderer shall demonstrate registration with umbrella and/or trade professional bodies Nigerian airline Operators.
- D. Tenderer shall demonstrate evidence of regulatory/practicing licenses and govt. authorities, permits, certification and standard authorities e.g. NCAA
- E. Tenderer shall demonstrate evidence of binding MOA with in-country facility owners of Maintenance hangers for execution of the work scope.
- F. Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian Registered Company, or a Nigerian Registered Company in genuine alliance or joint venture with foreign company with details on scope and responsibilities of parties for this work. Such companies must show evidence of joint venture binding agreement duly signed by the CEO of both companies including evidence or plans of physical operational presence and set-up in Nigeria
- G. Furnish details of company ownership and shareholding structure. Also submit clear photocopies of your CAC Forms CAC 2 and CAC 7.
- H. Provide evidence of the percentage of 1) key management positions that are held by Nigerians and 2) total work force that are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- Provide a Nigerian Content Execution Plan with a detailed description of the role, work scope, man-hours and responsibilities of all Nigerian companies and personnel that will be involved in executing the work. Also provide details of Nigerian Content contact or manager.
- J. State proposed total scope of work to be performed by Nigerian personnel (whether contracted directly or under subcontract agreements) with names and addresses including evidences of well-equipped offices and workshop; attach past experience of such patronage.
- K. Provide evidence of domiciliation of project management and procurement centers in Nigeria with physical addresses (not P.O. Box).
- L. Provide evidence of MOU with Oil & Gas Trainers Association of Nigeria (OGTAN) registered trainer to conduct classroom module of training and on the job attachment
- M.Provide human capacity building development plan including budget which must be minimum 10% of project man-hours or cost. Training will be targeted at developing capacity other than bidder's personnel. Trainees will be nominated from a database maintained by NCDMB and the services of OGTAN registered trainers utilized to cover classroom modules.

CLOSING DATE:

Only bidders who are **pre-qualified and 'live'** with NJQS Product/Category **3.08.03** (Air Transport Services of Passengers and Freight) by 16:00 Hours, Monday, July 15, 2019 being the advert close date shall be invited to submit technical bid.
