1. Introduction

Esso Exploration and Production Nigeria Limited (EEPNL), contractor of NNPC/EEPNL Production Sharing Contract plans to engage qualified contractors for the Logistics Co-ordination Services for Tanker Clearance to support EEPNL's Deep water offshore operations within the NNPC/EEPNL Production Sharing Contract (PSC) OML 133 and 138 acreages for an anticipated primary contract term of four years and one year optional extension period and is expected to commence in the third quarter of year 2019.

2. Brief description of the scope of services

The contractor will act as EEPN(OE)Limited and EEPNL representatives for USAN and ERHA Terminals respectively in coordination of activities for the purpose of Inward and Outward clearance for export tankers. Government Agencies are; Nigeria Customs Service, Nigeria Immigration Service and Port Health Services for USAN Terminal and Nigeria Customs Service, Nigeria Immigration Service for ERHATerminal.

The objective is to coordinate movement of Government officials between Bonny/Port Harcourt and the USAN FPSO, including Rivers State Customs, Immigration, Port Health and any other required agency. Also to coordinate movement of Government officials between Warri and the ERHA FPSO, including Delta State Customs, Immigration and any other required agency.

4. Nigerian Content

Esso Exploration and Production Nigeria Limited (EEPNL) is committed to the development of the Nigerian Oil and Gas business in compliance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act 2010 (NOGICD Act) enacted by the Federal Government of Nigeria in April 2010.

- 2. Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (assets, equipment, technical office, and administrative space, storage, workshop, assembly area, repair & maintenance, testing, laboratory, etc.) in Nigeria to support this contract.
- 3. For Nigerian company in alliance with a foreign company or multinational, submit evidence of binding agreement of the alliance duly signed by the CEO's of both parties.
- 4. Submit a plan on how it intends to give first consideration to goods and services provided from within Nigeria, to meet NC targets of 65% Spend for Logistics Management activities in line with the requirements of the Act.
- 5. Provide a project-specific training, man-hour budget, skill development and technology transfer plan for Nigerian personnel or indigenous business including evidence of past performance on training and development for Nigerians nationals & indigenous business. Plan for sponsorship of Nigerians to acquire competence and/or certification
- 6. Submit Tenderer's corporate organizational and project/contract specific organogram.
- 7. Proof of at least 50% Nigerian ownership of equipment for Geophysical and Geotechnical services
- 8. Provide category C NIGERIAN CONTENT EQUIPMENT CERTIFICATE (NCEC) issued by Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board in respect of Geophysical and Geotechnical equipment

Bidders' failure to comply with the NOGICD Act or demonstrate commitment to Nigerian Content development will result in Bidder's disqualification.
