CV's of all personnel (as required by the client and the service) listed in the project organogram should be submitted. For any position to be occupied by expatriate, tenderer shall provide evidence to obtain expatriate quota approval granted by NCDMB before any expatriate is deployed to execute this work scope".
- Details of in-country procurement plan and Binding MOA to source goods and V. materials.
- Provide minimum of 50% Nigeria equity ownership of equipment to be deployed vi. for this service and of the laboratory to be utilized for the analysis of the samples
- vii. Contractor shall be required to obtain category C NCEC (Nigerian Content Equipment Certificate) for equipment to be used in executing the work scope
- viii. Contractor shall demonstrate plan for the utilization of third party services of Nigerian origin and Nigerian subcontractor in executing this work scope
