### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

Mobil Producing Nigeria Unlimited (MPN) operator of the NNPC/MPN Joint Venture (JV) plans to carry out **Wireline Fishing and Pipe Recovery Services** on its offshore exploration, appraisal, and production location(s) in NNPC/MPN JV acreages. Anticipated contract term is two (2) years with an additional one (1) year option period. Contract commencement is expected in the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) quarter of 2018, and is to be awarded to more than one bidder with the lowest responsive evaluated price/rate.

### 2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work includes but is not limited to the provision of Wireline Fishing, Pipe Recovery, Bridge Plug Setting and Tractor Services, without limiting the Contractor's other obligations. Equipment shall include all rental and purchase components, operator control systems, spares and consumables, standby equipment. Compliance with API RP 8B recommended Practice for Procedures for Inspections, Maintenance, Repair, and Remanufacture of Hoisting Equipment and DS-1 Service Level 3-5 inspection standards for equipment tool joints and body dimensions are expected. Wireline Fishing and Pipe Recovery Services may be required during production or drilling/workover operations as the need arises. Drilling operations will be on Jack-up rigs.

### 3.0 MANDATORY REQUIREMENT

- i. To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested Bidders are required to be pre-qualified in the Category 3.04.11 (Fishing-Wireline Fishing Services) in NipeX Joint Qualification Scheme (NJQS) database. **All successfully prequalified suppliers in this category will receive Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT)**
- ii. To confirm if you are pre-qualified and view the product /service category you are listed for: Open <http://vendors.nipexjqs.com> and access NJQS with your log in details. Click on Products/Services tab to view status and product codes.
- iii. If you are not listed in this product/service category and you are registered with DPR, please contact NipeX office at 30 Oyinkan Abayomi Street, Ikoyi Lagos with your DPR certificate as evidence for verification and necessary update.

- v. To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigeria Content requirements in the NipeX system

### 4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT

Company is committed to the development of the Nigerian Oil and Gas business in compliance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act 2010 (NOGICD Act) enacted by the Federal Government of Nigeria in April 2010.

As from the commencement of this Act, the minimum Nigerian Content in any project, service or product specification to be executed in the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry shall be consistent with the level set in the Schedule to the Act and any other targets as may be directed by the Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board (NCDMB).

MPN requires their Contractors to comply with the Act, its attached Schedule and any applicable regulation developed by the NCDMB.

Nigerian Content (NC) in the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry is defined as:

“The quantum of composite value added to or created in the Nigerian economy by a systematic development of capacity and capabilities through the deliberate utilization of Nigerian human, material resources and services in the Nigerian oil and gas industry.”

"Nigerian Company" is a company formed and registered in Nigeria in accordance with the provisions of Companies and Allied Matters Act with not less than 51% equity shares by Nigerians.

Bidders shall consider Nigerian content as an important element of their overall project development and management philosophy for project execution.

**As part of their Technical tender submissions, Bidders shall:**

- a. Provide evidence of office address in Nigeria (physical address not P.O.Box,) and DPR certificate for this service.
- b. Demonstrate that the bidding entity is registered on the NOGIC JQS.
- c. Evidence that a minimum of 50% of all equipment deployed to work by multinational and international companies are owned by the Nigerian subsidiary
- d. Demonstrate that its entity is a Nigerian registered company, defined as a company formed and registered in Nigeria in accordance with the provision of Company and Allied Matters Act. Provide details of its Ownership Structure. Submit certified true copies of CAC form (C02 and CO7) including Memorandum and Article of Association. For Nigerian company in alliance with a foreign company or multinational, submit evidence of binding agreement of the alliance duly signed by the CEO's of both parties
- e. Submit a plan on how it intends to give first consideration to goods and services provided from within Nigeria, to meet 90% man-hours NC target in line with the requirements of the Act
- f. Demonstrate 100% utilization of Nigerian national employees in all category of personnel positions including key personnel for this service
- g. Submit a Plan on how tenderer intends to provide NC employment, Human Capacity Development and Personnel Training for supervisors, specialists and tools operators
- h. Present their valid Nigerian Content Equipment Certificate (NCEC) for this service or evidence of an approved application by NCDMB
- i. Provide procurement plan for all consumables and Materials e.g., how tenderer plan to procure OCTG, Pipes, Valves and other items from NOGIC JQS categorized and approved local suppliers/vendors having facilities in-country for assembling and finishing the products supply locally

Bidders' failure to comply with the NOGICD Act or demonstrate commitment to Nigerian Content development will result in Bidder's disqualification.

## **5.0 CLOSE DATE**

Only Bidders who are pre – qualified with NJQS Product/Service Category 3.04.11 as at January 22, 2018 being the advert close date shall be invited to submit Technical bids.

## **6.0 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- a) Interested suppliers must be prequalified for this product/service category in NJQS
- b) Full tendering procedure will be provided only to contractors that have been successfully prequalified in NJQS
- c) This advertisement shall neither be construed as an Invitation to Tender (ITT) nor a commitment on the part of MPN to award a contract to any supplier and/or associated companies, sub-contractors or agents
- d) This advertisement shall not entitle prequalified companies to make any claims whatsoever, and/or seek any indemnity from MPN and/or its partners by virtue of such companies having been prequalified in NJQS
- e) All costs incurred in registering and prequalifying for this and other product/service categories in NJQS shall be borne solely by suppliers
