4. NIGERIAN CONTENT

Bidders are invited to express complete understanding, willingness and commitment to comply with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development (NOGICD) Act, 2010 and Insurance ACT 2003. Consequently, bidders' submissions shall be evaluated strictly with the minimum evaluation criteria defined in the NOGICD Act.

The documentation for evaluation shall include but not limited to the following:

- Only Nigerian registered Companies with 51% or greater Nigerian shareholding shall bid for this work scope. Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian indigenous company, Provide details of its Ownership Structure. Submit certified true copies of CAC form (CO2 and CO7) including Memorandum and Article of Association. Including evidence of being registered on the NCDMB NOGICJQS.
- Provide description of in-country committed infrastructure (asset, equipment, technical office, and administrative space, storage, workshop, assembly area and repair etc) in Nigeria to support this contract.
- Tenderer shall submit valid proof of Nigerian Automotive Council manufacturers Association of Nigeria, Ministry of commerce and Industry.
- Tenderer shall demonstrate that 50% of all the vehicles to be procured are assembled in Nigeria in line with the Federal Government of Nigeria executive order 003 and the FGN automotive policy.
- Tenderer shall provide evidence of memorandum of agreement with OEM accredited assembly plants in-country for procurement of vehicles, spare parts and components.
- Provide description of Project-specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel in key areas, In line with NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative.
