Consequently, bidders' submissions shall be evaluated strictly with the minimum evaluation criteria defined in the NOGICD Act.

The documentation for evaluation shall include but not be limited to the following:

1. Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian indigenous company, Provide details of its Ownership Structure. Submit certified true copies of CAC form (CO2 and CO7) including Memorandum and Article of Association. Including evidence of being registered on the NCDMB NOGICJQS.
2. Provide description of in-country committed infrastructure (asset, equipment, technical office, and administrative space, storage, workshop, assembly area, repair, and laboratory, testing, etc) in Nigeria (offices, equipment etc) to support this contract.
3. Demonstrate in-country sourcing of the base raw materials and chemicals
4. Demonstrate in accordance with the NOGICD Act 2010, a minimum of 90% in-country spend as specified in the Schedule A for this service, NCEC approval for this product and service category.
5. Provide description of Project-specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel in key areas, In line with NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative.
