Nigerian Agip Oil Company Limited (NAOC) intends to put in place a Contracts for supply of AGO and PMS to NAOC Locations in Port Harcourt, Brass, Land Areas (OB/OB, Kwale, Ebocha etc.), Abuja and Lagos. Contractor shall cover all costs and expenses for all services provided hereunder for the duration of the contract. The proposed contract shall cover a period of two (2) years firm plus one (1) year optional duration.

- Supplier may be required to deliver AGO to other locations (RIGS/Flowstations).

- c) To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.

**4. NIGERIAN CONTENT**

Bidders are invited to express complete understanding and willingness to comply with provisions of the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development (NOGICD) Act 2010. Consequently, bidders' submissions shall be evaluated strictly with the minimum evaluation criteria defined in 'The Act'.

The documentation for evaluation shall include, but not limited to the following:

- a) Only Nigerian registered companies with 51% or greater Nigerian shareholding shall bid for this work scope. Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian indigenous company, Provide details of its Ownership Structure. Submit certified true copies of CAC form (C02 and C07) including Memorandum and Article of Association. Including evidence of being registered on the NCDMB NOGIC JQS.
- b) Nigerian Content Plan that demonstrates the full utilization of Nigerian labour and services with detailed description of role, work scope and man-hours in order to achieve the minimum target as set out in the requirements of the NOGICD Act 2010. Where in-country capacity is inadequate, propose innovations to bridge the gap.
- c) Provide evidence (personnel list) of percentage management that are Nigerian nationals and of the total workforce that are Nigerians.
- d) Provide evidence to show that a minimum of 50% of the equipment to be deployed for the work is owned by the Nigerian subsidiary if international
- e) Bidder's sourcing strategy/plan for this scope of service; and evidence of source of products, materials e.t.c. with details of the applicants relationship with local suppliers and service providers e.g. in the management of logistics, personnel e.t.c.
- f) Tenderer shall demonstrate Evidence of detailed description & location of in-country facilities & infrastructure not limited to administrative office, Tank Farm, technical office, Testing Laboratory and Storage facility.
- g) Tenderer shall demonstrate Ownership of vessel (Marine Tanker/barge) categorized as Nigerian owned in the latest NCDMB Marine Tanker Categorization report or provide MOA with a category A/AA/AAA vendor owning the nominated marine vessel/tanker categorized on the latest NCDMB marine vessel categorization.
- h) In Line with NCD Human capacity Development Initiative, Bidder shall commit to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, Budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian Personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution.
