2.0 SCOPE OF WORK/SERVICE REQUIREMENT

The scope of work shall include but will not be limited to provision of the following services:

The scope of the contract is for the procurement, quality assurance and transportation, handling, transfer, storage and delivery of Automotive Gas Oil (AGO) by Oil product tanker vessels to Swamp offshore locations. Estimated amount is 6,000,000liters/year.

- d. To initiate the JQS pre-qualification process, access www.nipex-ng.com to download the application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.
- e. To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system

4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT

Tenderers are to note that they will be requested during the technical tender to give full details of their relevant strategy to ensure that they fully comply with the Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development (NOGICD) Act, 2010 as non-compliance will constitute a FATAL FLAW in all tender evaluations. In line with the above, Tenderers will be required to ensure that information on the following, among others, is included in their technical submission:

- 2. List of equipment, materials and goods that are to be locally sourced on this project
- 3. Where a company is in joint venture partnership or consortium, evidence of such a relationship in form of MOA or pre-bid agreement signed by the chief executives of both companies and partners.





- 4. Name and address of any Subcontractor, Vendor or Supplier performing any part of the Work using Nigerian Labor or Material.
- 5. Detailed description of part of Services being performed by Contractor, any Subcontractor or Vendor or Supplier using Nigerian labour, indigenous Subcontractor or Services. The analysis must relate the percentage of work being done utilizing Nigerians to the overall total Work Scope.
- 6. Detailed description of any proposed 'Training Programs' to train Nigerian Nationals to enable Contractor, Subcontractors, Suppliers to perform the Work including the 'Numbers of Personnel to be trained', the 'Type of Training', and the 'Training Schedule'.
- 7. Contractor's Nigerian Content Execution Plan is incorporated and made an integral part of the Contract.
- 8. Location of Project Management Team and Procurement Center in Nigeria.
- 9. Provide details of in-Nigeria assets (workshops, repair shops and storage).
- 10. Provide details of ownership and shareholding structure.
- 11. Submit photocopies of Corporate Affairs Forms CAC 2, CAC 7, and CAC 10
