TENDER OPPORTUNITY: IMPLEMENTATION OF TETRA COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK IN SPDC (NipeX Tender No: 1000004632)

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Shell Petroleum Development Company of Nigeria Limited (SPDC) in its role as Operator of the NNPC/SHELL/TEPN/AGIP Joint Venture hereby announces to interested and prequalified companies an upcoming tendering opportunity for Implementation of Tetra Communications Network in SPDC.

SPDC plans to further expand its Tetra digital trunked radio network to provide coverage over its entire geographical oil concession area in the Niger Delta region. Currently, SPDC's Tetra network coverage is over a relatively sizeable portion of its operational area in the Eastern Division and is composed of Motorola Dimetra central switch, several Motorola MTS2 repeaters installed, with several dozens of Motorola MTP8550EX hand portables, MTM5400 mobile and base radios.

The implementation of this expansion of SPDC's Tetra Network shall be deployed using existing SPDC's telecommunication infrastructure. SPDC hereby invites reputable and competent Nigerian Companies and alliances with the requisite expertise in Motorola systems, experience, skilled manpower and Technology to apply to be considered for inclusion in the bidders list for subject tender.

The proposed contract will provisionally commence in Q4 2020 and remain active for 2 years' duration, followed by 1-year extension option.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK/SERVICE REQUIREMENT

The scope of work for the services shall include but not limited to

- Detailed survey of the sites to assess current state of existing Telecom infrastructure
- Perform an integration design showing detailed telecom and data communications interface
- Acquire licenses from the Ministry of Communications (MOC) to cover the planned frequencies.
- Procure, install, integrate and commission fixed base stations and mobile repeaters (on vehicles and boats).
- Provide Tetra hand portables
- Procure, install and commission mobile radios (for vehicles & boats)
- Procure, install and commission desk / base radios
- Implement the Tetra AUL (Automatic User Locator) system for installed hand portables and mobile radios
- Procure, install and commission Tetra Gateways (DMO/TMO repeaters for temporary coverage extension to areas with weak or no signals)
- Decommission existing VHF/UHF trunk radio and disused antennas as may be necessary
- Provide Tetra hardware spares and post installation support and maintenance (where required)
- Provide OEM training on tetra technology, installation, maintenance and operation.
- Perform formal coverage drive testing, commissioning and handover to Telecoms Operations for maintenance and support.

3.0 MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

 To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested contractors are required to be to pre-qualified as essential service vendors in the 1.14.05 – Networking Equipment/Telecommunication Equipment and Systems and 3.11.09 – Telecommunication systems, integration Installation/Support Services product groups in NipeX

Only Tenderers who are registered in the 1.14.05 – Networking Equipment/Telecommunication Equipment and Systems and 3.11.09 – Telecommunication systems, integration Installation/Support Services NJQS product categories as at 24th July 2020 being the advert close date shall be invited to submit Technical bids.

- I. Tenderer shall provide evidence of company Ownership Structure form CO2 and CO7, registration on NOGIC JQS and DPR certificate.
- II. Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Administrative/Technical offices) in Nigeria to support this contract
- III. Provide a project-specific training, man-hour budget, skill development and technology transfer plan for Nigerian personnel or indigenous business including evidence of past performance on training and development for Nigerians nationals & indigenous business. Plan for sponsorship of Nigerians to acquire competence and/or certification. Further development of local employees as professionals. Bidders are requested to execute an enforceable MOA with Local Training Service Provider (OGTAN member) for the provision of training services in specific technical disciplines involved in the project.
- IV. Submit Tenderer's corporate organizational and project/contract specific organogram. CV's of all personnel listed in the project organogram should be submitted. For any position to be occupied by expatriate, tenderer shall provide evidence to obtain expatriate quota approval granted by NCDMB before any expatriate is deployed to execute this work scope". Complete the Personnel manning below.
- V. Provide evidence of at least 50% Nigerian ownership of Equipment as stated in the scope of work.
- VI. Tenderer shall provide evidence of Nigerian Communications Commission's (NCC) permit/license
- VII. Tenderer shall provide details of in-country procurement plan and Binding MOA to source goods and materials.
