INTRODUCTION

Star Deep Water Petroleum Limited (SDWPL), a Chevron Company (Company) invites interested prequalified companies for this tender opportunity for the Provision of Insulation Repair Services required to support the Agbami Floating Production Storage and Offloading (FPSO) Vessel operations, which is located in approximately 5000 feet of water and about 70 miles offshore Nigeria.

The services are estimated to commence first quarter 2020 for two (2) years with an optional 1-year extension.

SCOPE OF WORK/SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

The high-level scope of the proposed contract shall include but not limited to:

- Procurement, Construction and installation of a high temperature/chemical resistant blanket on the exhaust of gas turbines.
- Construction and installation of watershed deflector on the exhaust expansion joint of the gas turbine.
- Design, construction, removal, repair and replace damaged insulations on fixed equipment at low and high temperatures and pressures
- Design, construction, removal, repair and replace damaged insulations on HVAC systems
- Fabrication of insulation materials onshore at Contractor's workshop
- Fabrication of insulation materials at Contractor's workshop and mobilize the fabricated insulation materials to Agbami FPSO for installation.
- Construction, repair and replacement of damaged insulation on fixed equipment (pressure vessels and piping) with insulation materials of the same type or better quality and design at Agbami FPSO.
- Contractor shall construct, repair, and replace demanded insulations on fixed equipment
- Removal, repair and replace damaged insulations

- E. To be eligible, all interested bidders must comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.

NIGERIAN CONTENT

SDWPL is committed to the development of the Nigerian Oil and Gas business in observance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act 2010 (NOGICD Act) enacted by the Federal Government of Nigeria in April 2010.

Pursuant to enactment of the NOGICD Act, the minimum Nigerian Content in any project, service or product specification to be executed in the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry shall be consistent with the level set in the schedule of the Act and any other target as may be directed by the Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board (NCDMB).

Contractors shall comply with the provisions of the NOGICD Act and all applicable regulations. Bidders that do not meet the Nigerian Content criterion will not be allowed to participate in next Tender Stage

The following are the Nigerian Content requirements bidders are expected to comply with in their technical bid submission.

- A. Furnish details of company ownership and share holding structure. Also submit clear photocopies of your CAC Forms CO2 and Co7

- B. Provide evidence of the percentage of 1) key management positions that are held by Nigerians and 2) total work force that are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- C. Provide a Nigerian Content Plan with a detailed description of the role, work scope, man-hours and responsibilities of all Nigerian companies and personnel that will be involved in executing the work. Also provide details of Nigerian Content contact or manager.
- D. State proposed total scope of work to be performed by Nigerian personnel (whether contracted directly or under subcontract agreements) with names and addresses including evidences of well equipped offices and workshop; attach experience of such patronage.
- E. Location of in-country facilities, (Equipment, storage, workshops, repair & maintenance facilities and, testing facilities).
- F. Bidder must be willing and able to provide evidence of maximization of made in Nigeria goods and services.
- G. Provide human capacity building development plan including budget which must be minimum 10% of project man-hours or cost. Training will be targeted at developing capacity other than bidder's personnel. Trainees will be nominated from a database maintained by NCDMB and the services of OGTAN registered trainers utilized to cover classroom modules.
- H. Bidders (Vendors, Original Equipment, Manufacturers-OEMs, and EPC Contractors) are required to present Nigerian Content Equipment Certificate (NCEC) issued by Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board (or evidence of application for the certificate) in respect of any components, spares, equipments, systems and packages to be used in the proposed project under tender
- I. All Bidders for a project/contract/service with a completion period of 12 months or more are required to submit as part of the Nigerian Content requirement, a signed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between it and one of the research and development (R&D) clusters established by the NCDMB. The MOA shall be relevant to the project and shall indicate how the bidder intends to use the relevant R&D clusters during project execution.

Only bidders who pre-qualified and live with NJQS Product/Category **3.05.05 - Insulation Services - Acoustic, Cladding, Cold surfaces, Cryogenic, Hot surfaces, Pipeline, personal protection, Thermal** category by 16:00 Hours, **Tuesday 9, July, 2019** being the advert close date shall be invited to submit both Technical and Commercial bids.

- The Invitation to Tender (ITT) and any further progression of this tender shall be via NipeX.
