- C. Provide in-country committed facility not limited to administrate and Technical office.
- D. In line with HCD guidelines, Tenderer shall submit Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
