CALL FOR TENDER FOR THE PROVISION OF THREE (3) ACCOMMODATION BARGES FOR THE PLANNED FULL FIELD SHUTDOWN AND IKIKE PROJECT OFFSHORE IN Q1 2021

1. INTRODUCTION

Total E&P Nigeria Limited (TEPNG) operator of the NNPC/TOTAL Joint Venture invites interested and pre-qualified companies for this tender opportunity for provision of three (3) Accommodation Barges for the planned Full Field Shutdown and the IKIKE Project, Offshore, Nigeria. The commencement date is expected to occur in Q1, 2021.

The expected duration of the contracts is;

- Eighteen (18) months firm plus three (3) months optional extension for the 300 Pax Anchored type barge,
- Six (6) months firm plus three (3) months optional extension for the 500 Pax anchored type
- Nine (9) months firm plus three (3) months optional extension for the 500 Pax DP3 type barge (Dp2 type barge could be considered)

SCOPE OF WORK AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE THREE (3) ACCOMMODATION

- The scope of work consists of activities required and incidental to the provision of the Accommodation Barges, offshore Nigeria. These services shall involve, but not be limited to the following activities within the specifications and capabilities of the BARGES and her crew:
 - Safety Stand-by
 - Cargo transportation / Cargo Lifting and Handling Operations
 - Company Personnel accommodation
 - Oil spill clearance
 - Fire fighting
- Brief description of required Barges:

 - 500 Pax, DP3 type (DP2 type barge could be considered) with Clear deck area: minimum 1000 m2 @ 10t/m2 for storage area and light workshop (including full catering and housekeeping SERVICE)

- - Part of the TENDERER's Proposal shall include full and comprehensive catering on each of the three (3) Barges above.
- TENDERER shall provide associated Catering SUB-CONTRACT MANAGEMENT Supported by ONSHORE OFFICE & BASE SUPPORT:
 - Be supported by experienced ISM compliant onshore ship technical management and support organization with proven track record with TUCN and/or other IOCs for provision
 - State if Technical Partnership is in place with other shipping company for the technical management of the vessels on contract particularly Required if TENDERED does not have the necessary level of ISM compliant competent Technical Management or if it is not available with the Contractor's organization.

 - An individual award shall be made on the basis of lowest commercially acceptable bids amongst the technically qualified bidders for each type/capacity of Barge. However, if the lowest commercially qualified bidder fails to provide the Barge for immediate deployment, he automatically forfeits it and the contract will be awarded to the second lowest commercially qualified bidder at the lowest bidder price.

- Tenderer shall demonstrate evidence of Nigerian ownership of the 300 POB accommodation Barge duly categorized as 'Nigerian owned' on the latest NCDMB NOGIC JQS marine vessel categorization report.
- Tenderer shall submit verifiable proof of its registration with the regulatory agency i.e. NIMASA current year valid certificate of Nigerian registration licence as a shipping company.
