TENDER OPPORTUNITY FOR: PROVISION OF ONSHORE LAND RIG SERVICES FOR OML 58 DRILLING CAMPAIGN 2022-2023 NipeX Tender Number: 1000004879

1. INTRODUCTION

Total Exploration and Production Nigeria Limited (TEPNG) operator of the NNPC/TOTAL Joint venture invites interested reputable and pre-qualified contractors with relevant experience for this tender opportunity for "Provision of Onshore Land Rig Services for OML 58 Drilling Campaign 2022-2023".

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The land rig will be used to drill seven infill development wells, deviated, and carry out work-over operations. It is scheduled to start operations with the rig in Q1 2022. The land rig shall have at least the following characteristics:

- Rig maximum drilling depth = 5,500 m with 5½" drill pipes
- Mast gross nominal capacity 1,250,000 lbs
- Drawworks 2200 HP.
- Top Drive Varco TDS-4 or equivalent.
- 3 x mud pumps 1600 HP each.
- Mud tank capacity = 450 m³.
- 10,000 psi WP 3 Rams BOP and 5000 psi WP Annular preventer with 2 kill lines minimum 2" ID and 1 choke line minimum 3" ID.
- 10K choke manifold with 3 chokes (2 manually + 1 remotely operated), minimum ID 3", 1 bypass line, 2 buffer chambers.
- Rig skidding capability
- Contractor must be a registered member of IADC or its local organization or chapter in Nigeria.

The scope of work for the Rig is as below –

- 3 Ibewa infill wells
- 1 OBD-1N Oil well
- 1 Obagi Infill gas well
- Obagi Major gas cap (2 wells)

3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested contractors are required to be pre-qualified in the **3.04.01 (Drilling Rigs and Production/ drilling Services) categories in NipeX joint Qualification system (NJQS) database**. All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in this category will receive an Invitation to Tender (ITT).
- To determine if you are pre-qualified and can view the product/service category you are listed for; Open **vendors.nipex-ng.com** and access NJQS with your log in details. Click on Products/Services Status tab to view your status and product codes.
- If you are not listed in a product/service category and you are registered with DPR to do business, contact NipeX office at No 8-10, Bayo Kuku Street, Ikoyi Lagos with your DPR certificate as evidence for verification and necessary update.
- To initiate the JQS pre-qualification process, access **www.nipex-ng.com**, to download the application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.
- To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian content requirements in the NipeX system.

4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT:

TEPNG is committed to the development of the Nigerian Oil and gas business in compliance with the Nigerian Content Act 2010 for Nigerian Content Development.

As from the commencement of this Act, the minimum Nigerian Content in any project, service or product specification to be executed in the Nigerian oil and gas industry shall be consistent with the level set in the Schedule of the Act and any other targets as may be directed by the Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board (The Board).

Tenderer(s) shall comply with all the provisions of the Nigerian Content Act that relate to this advert and in particular comply with the minimum Nigerian Content percentage for the scopes which are covered in the Schedule of the Act.

This also includes any other requirement that may arise from time to time not explicitly stated in this advert, but which apply to the service in fulfillment of the Nigerian Content Act, in the submission of their Tender. Failure to fully comply with the Nigerian Content Act or demonstrate commitment to Nigerian Content Development Policy of the Nigerian government shall result in the disqualification of the tenderer from the bidding process.

As part of their submissions, Tenderer shall:

- shall demonstrate that bidding entity is a: NIGERIAN REGISTERED COMPANY or INDIGENOUS COY Or MOA/JV with a Multinational COY. Tenderer shall provide evidences of Evidence of CAC registration, CAC form C02 and C07, NOGIC JQS

registration, DPR Certificate and MOA/JV agreement (if applicable) as supporting documents.

- For this onshore drilling rig, tenderer shall demonstrate at least one of the following;
 - Tenderer shall demonstrate that Nigerian entity owns the onshore drilling rig. OR
 - Tenderer shall provide MOA with the rig owner stating clearly the relationship, the rig owner structure, and plan to acquire at least 10% of the rig and subsequently increase to 50% for the onshore drilling rig within the duration of the contract. And;
 - Evidence of bidding entity demonstrating compliance in 70% manning targets for Nigerian manning of key positions on the rig plus significant utilization of in-country support services in the operations of rig while on contract.
- Tenderer shall submit:
 - Corporate organizational and project/contract specific organogram
 - CV's of all personnel listed in the project organogram not limited to rig manager, assistance rig manager, rig engineer, driller, assistant driller, derrick man, floor man, subsea engineer etc.
 - Commitment to obtaining expatriate quota approval granted by NCDMB for any position to be occupied by expatriate
 - Provide a detailed manning organogram for the rig showing at least 70% by man-hours of the personnel positions and manning level on-board the rig to be occupied by Nigerian national employees.
- Tenderer shall demonstrate capability for:
 - Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Assets, technical office, and administrative space, storage, workshop, assembly area, repair & maintenance, testing, laboratory, etc.) in Nigeria to support this contract or submit a credible and verifiable plan towards setting-up.
- Provide Local procurement plan for drilling equipment, materials and goods that are to be locally sourced on this project couple with MOA with the Nigerian vendor.
- Tenderer shall provide MOA with Nigerian Subcontractors for major subcontracts such as minor/major maintenance of the rig, catering services, housekeeping services etc.
- In line with NCDMB Human Capacity Development Initiative, provide details on contract-specific training man-hours for Nationals to consolidate the National skill pool.
- The focus will be on Land Rigs already in Nigeria. However, with possibility of international expansion if the Land Rigs already in the country do not meet the stated requirements.

NOTE: Failure to comply with the provision of the Nigerian Content Act 2010 or to demonstrate commitment to the development of the Nigerian Content Policy shall result in disqualification from this bidding process.

Only Tenderers who are pre-qualified and LIVE in the 3.04.01 (Drilling Rigs and Production/ drilling Services) categories in NipeX joint Qualification system (NJQS) database as at this advert closing date shall be invited to submit Technical/ Commercial Bids. Close date of advert is **04/11/2020**.

6. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Failure to provide any of the listed documents or information may automatically disqualify the Supplier.
- This notice and the ensuing qualification process neither create any commitment by TEPNG nor establish any legal relationship with TEPNG.
- All costs incurred in registering and pre-qualifying for this and other service categories in NJQS shall be borne solely by the Contractors/suppliers.
