1. INTRODUCTION

Total Exploration and Production Nigeria Limited (TEPNG) operator of the NNPC/TOTAL Joint venture invites interested reputable and pre-qualified contractors with Self Elevating Work Over Platform (SEWOP) and relevant experience for this tender opportunity for "Provision of Self Elevating Work Over Platform (SEWOP) for Well Interventions and Integrity related operations".

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of Services include provision of a Self-Elevating Self Propelled "Lift Boat" [Self Elevating Work Over Platform (SEWOP)] together with operational Crew aimed at the realization of light well interventions, integrity maintenance and Associated Services on COMPANY's offshore Field Operations. This SEWOP shall have at least the following characteristics:

4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT:

Failure to fully comply with the Nigerian Content Act or demonstrate commitment to Nigerian Content Development Policy of the Nigerian government shall result in the disqualification of the tenderer from the bidding process.

As part of their submissions, Tenderer shall:

- a. Develop a Nigerian Content Execution Plan (NCP), which shall explain the methodology of how it intends to comply with the requirements of the Act and how to achieve the set target(s) in the Schedule of Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development Act and any targets set by The Board.
- b. Tenderers shall be categorized A/AA vendors and own the nominated Self-Elevating Work-Over Platform (SEWOP)/Jack-up Barges, duly categorized as Nigerian owned in the latest NCDMB NOGIC JQS marine vessel categorization report.
- In the event that the technical specification of the SEWOP is outside the competence of these c. Nigerian companies owning SEWOP, NCDMB authorization for importation shall be sought and the SEWOP shall only be imported by Nigerian indigenous companies who have demonstrated ownership of SEWOP in-country.
- International or multinational company working through a Nigerian subsidiary must demonstrate d. that a minimum of 50% of equipment to be deployed for execution of work shall be owned by the Nigerian subsidiary
- Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian indigenous company with greater than or equal to 51% e. Nigerian shareholding. Provide details of its Ownership Structure. Submit certified true copies of CAC form (C02 and CO7) including Memorandum and Article of Association. Including evidence of being registered on the NCDMB NOGIC JQS
- Provide location of in-country infrastructure and facilities not limited to administrative officer, workshops, repair & maintenance facilities. e.t.c).
- In line with the NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative, Bidder shall commit to providing g. Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- Provide evidence (personnel list and positions with organization chart to substantiate) of h. percentage of management that are Nigerian Nationals and the percentage of the total workforce that are Nigerians.
- Submit Tenderer's corporate organization's overall human resources structure (mgt, supervisors, senior & junior skilled officers, etc) identifying positions manned/occupied.

NOTE: Failure to comply with the provision of the Nigerian Content Act 2010 or to demonstrate commitment to the development of the Nigerian Content Policy shall result is disqualification from this bidding process.

5. CLOSING DATE

Only Tenderers who are pre-qualified in the 3.04.01 (Drilling Rigs and Production/ drilling Services) and 3.08.04 (accommodation platforms / vessels) categories in NipeX joint Qualification system (NJQS) database as at this advert closing date shall be invited to submit Technical Bids.
