TENDER OPPORTUNITY CHARTER AND OPERATION OF ONE BRAND NEW DIVING SUPPORT VESSEL FOR SWAMP AND DEEPOFFSHORE OPERATIONS.

1. INTRODUCTION

Nigerian Agip Oil Company Limited (NAOC) intends to award a contract for the charter and operation of one brand new Diving support Vessel.

The work location shall be Nigeria Agip Oil Company (Nigeria) Limited Swamp and Deep Offshore locations.

The proposed contract shall have duration of five (5) years effective from the date of supply and acceptance.

NAOC therefore uses this medium to inform suitable and reputable Companies having requisite experience and resources for the execution of project of this magnitude to register or update their registration with NipeX for consideration in the subject opportunity.

2. SCOPE OF SERVICE

The Scope of work shall include but not limited to the following activities:

- ➤ Age of the Vessel should not be more than ten (10) years.
- Provide enough accommodation and feeding on board for the crew and any Company authorized passenger.
- Ability to professionally render services on Nigerian coastal and inland waters as may be requested by the Company.
- Ability to combat oil pollution and fire out break. Equipped to conduct search and rescue operations at sea.
- Serve as watch keeping vessels on offshore facilities and equipped to conduct search and rescue operations at sea.
- The boats must be crewed with professional seamen and so equipped as to be able to handle efficiently all jobs
- ➤ All related service pertaining to:
 - Charter and Operations of Diving Support Vessel
 - Buoy Operating Platform (BOP)
 - Sealine Brass B. O. P
 - Maintenance of SPM's at Brass
 - Provision of self contained ROV
 - Conductor Pipes and Rig Legs
 - Extra ordinary diving services(Min of 7 Divers)
 - Drilling Platforms on Call-out Basis
 - Close Visual Inspection (CVI)
 - Onshore/Offshore Operations

Ability to serve as Supply Vessel for both heavy and light materials and utility items.

3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in this categories will receive Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT).
- b) To determine if you are pre-qualified and view the product/service category you are listed for: Open www.nipex-ng.com and access NJQS with your log in details, click on continue Joint Qualification Scheme tool, click check my supplier status and then click supplier product group.
- If you are not listed in a product/service category but you are registered with DPR to do business, contact NipeX office at 30, Oyinkan Abayomi Street, Ikoyi Lagos with your DPR certificate as

evidence for verification and necessary update.

- d) To initiate the NJQS pre-qualification process, access <u>www.nipex-ng.com</u> to download application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.
- e) To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.

4. NIGERIAN CONTENT

Bidders are invited to express complete understanding, willingness and commitment to develop in-country capability and capacity for related items in compliance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act (NOGICD Act, 2010).

Pursuant to the above, bidders' submissions shall be evaluated strictly with the minimum evaluation criteria defined in the NOGICD Act provisions and Schedule. Only bidders whose submissions are in compliance shall proceed to the next stage of the tendering process

The following are some information/documentation that will be required for submission at the ITT stage:

- 1. Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian Registered Company, or Nigerian Registered Company as the contracting entity in genuine alliance or joint venture with foreign company with details on scope and responsibilities of parties for this work. Such companies must show evidence of joint venture binding agreement duly signed by the CEO of both companies including evidence or plans of physical operational presence and set-up in Nigeria
- 2. Nigerian Content Plan with detailed description of the role, work scope, manhours and responsibilities of all Nigerian companies and personnel that are involved in executing the service;
- 3. Details of Company ownership and shareholding structure with certified true copies of CAC forms CO2 and CO7, including company memorandum & article of association and other evidence of entity's incorporation;
- 4. Supplier's sourcing strategy/plan for this scope of service; and evidence of source of products, materials etc.;
- 5. Current and in-place organization structure with detailed experience and skills of key management personnel with names;
- 6. Evidence (personnel list and positions with organization chart to substantiate) of percentage of management that are Nigerian nationals and the percentage of the total workforce that are Nigerians;
- 7. Detailed training plan for the service;
- 8. Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (assets, equipment, storage facilities etc) in Nigeria to support this contract or submit a credible and verifiable plan towards setting-up;
- Details of the applicant's relationship with local suppliers and service providers (e.g. in the management of the logistic, personnel);
- 10. Your detail training plan for the Nigerian crew or cadets supported by their CVs and stating the training disciplines, man-hours and duration on
- 11. Provide the list and percentage of your vessels crew that are Nigerians supported by their CVs.
- 12. Evidence of companies with Nigerian Flag registration and Nigerian Crew.
- 13. Provide three-year plan for increasing the Nigerian content of your vessel

- Bidders shall be requested to provide evidence to show their compliance with the above listed requirements at the ITT stage.
- Failure to meet the Nigerian Content requirements is a "FATAL FLAW."
