CHALLENGES TO EFFECTIVE BID SUBMISSION: Java Constraint

Most suppliers commonly have challeng-

es at the Download or Upload section * when responding to ITT.

Remember that downloading or Uploading of bid takes place in the C-folder and it is java driven.

Two common challenges which are linked to java are discussed in this Volume 66 of the e-Newsletter.

JAVA RELATED CHALLENGES:

1. says "your security settings have blocked an application signed with an expired or not yet valid certificate from running".

To resolve this challenge, kindly click on the "Java SecurityV2 tip" as shown below in pdf attachment and follow the instructions as directed:

- go to the control panel
- Click on JAVA
- Click on Security Tab
- Click on Edit site list
- Click on Add
- Enter; http://secure.nipex-ng.com

- Click on OK
- Re-start the computer system
- Logon to the eMarket 7.0 portal
- Refresh

2. When the java outlet does not display the Local Source Directory.

When this happens, it implies that either java is not installed in the computer sys-The system prompts a message that tem or the java version is now outdated.

- To resolve this challenge the most recent java should be installed;
 - go to java.com and download java script .The steps to achieving this are available from internet and the system prompts you through the required steps.
- Verify the installed java
- Restart the computer system

Note that for an outdated java, the above steps also apply but the old java version MUST be uninstalled.

3. Sometimes, the computer system may have installed java and this challenges may also be encountered when the appropriate browser is not used.

The recommended browser is "Internet Explorer" (Not Chrome). If the java has expired, it gives an option to update.

Frequently Asked Questions

Questions:

1.0 After submission of my Bid response, if my response version is showing C_1 or C_2 , what is the implication of this?

Answer: Kindly note that:

- Whenever your response version in the Workcenter shows C₁ or C₂, it indicates the last update you did on your submission is not reflected.
- You must endeavor to make adjustment to the update and re-submit.
- Ideally, the response version should be numeric.

2.0 What should I do if I notice that the size of the document I uploaded in the "Add Attachment" under "Notes and Attachment" is showing 0KB?

- OKB indicates that nothing is submitted; delete the affected document and re-add the document.
- Click on "Save", "Edit Button", "Submit"

Always double check when responding to an RFQ because of the size of the uploaded documents.
