ACCESSING THE NipeX SYSTEM

IMPORTANCE OF THE NipeX TENDER ADVERT REVIEW PROCESS

OPPORTUNITY PHASE OF THE TENDER PROCESS-THE ROLE OF ^{2.} NipeX.

NipeX is the gatekeeper of the opportuni- 3. ty phase of the tendering process which is foundational to the achievement of the objectives of the tendering process. The task of gatekeeping can only be performed when the tender draft adverts and other relevant documents are submitted for NipeX review. The opportunity phase of the tendering process is pivotal to the realization of the objectives of placing the tender in the first instance. 5.

NipeX performs the tasks of a gatekeeper to ensure that the tenders are approved by both NAPIMS & NCDMB and that the tender adverts are consistent with the template approved by the NipeX Steering Committee.

Tender draft adverts are submitted by Operators for NipeX review to ensure compliance with laid-down guidelines. This is done to forestall missteps and mishaps with their attendant consequences.

WHY ARE TENDER ADVERTS & RELATED DOCUMENTS REVIEWED?

The importance of the NipeX tender advert review includes:

1. Ensuring that tender adverts are in agenda of the NNF line with the mandate of the NipeX requirements of NEITI. steering committee.

- Ensuring that adverts are in conformance with the approved industry template so that the required information can be gleaned easily from it.
- Confirmation of the correctness of crucial information like product codes, vendor URL, web and physical addresses, etc. These would enable the target audience to act accordingly and without preventable hitches.
- Approved tender adverts after review would be uploaded on the portal and be visible to a wide range of suppliers, ensuring universal access to opportunities
- It affords operators the privilege of receiving continuous assistance from NipeX on the publication of tender adverts.

IMPLICATIONS OF PUBLISHING AN UNRE-VIEWED TENDER ADVERT.

The Implication of tender adverts published in selected National Dailies without NipeX review includes that tender may not have been approved by either NCDMB or NA-PIMS (or even by both), the content of the advert, like product codes and NipeX portal and physical address may all be wrong.

Consequently, such a tender ends up stalled or mired in controversies and possibly litigation.

In addition, a tender advert that is not published on the NipeX portal leaves a significant number of pre-qualified suppliers disenfranchised. Thus, negating the TAPE agenda of the NNPC and transparency requirements of NEITI.
