NipeX OPERATIONS: JQS & eMARKETPLACE

The Joint Qualification System (JQS) is designed to pre-qualify Suppliers registered in Nigeria. It increases efficiency and instills integrity in the pre-qualification process of the Nigerian oil and gas industry.



The eMarketplace is a collaborative environment that delivers significant value to all Stakeholders in the contracting process through a comprehensive suite of capabilities.

THE CHALLENGE OF PRODUCT CODES AND DPR PERMITS SELECTION

The NipeX NJQS have been adjudged by almost all the Oil and Gas industry stakeholders as exemplary innovative success since its establishment over a decade ago. The benefits that the registered suppliers and vendors are deriving as well as the transparency the centralised online procurement management system has so far achieved contributed immensely in encouraging several other suppliers that are daily registering on the platform.

Despite the numerous successes achieved, there are still some grey areas that require serious attention. Some of these challenges include mapping of the product/service codes with the appropriate DPR permits during the questionnaire stage of the pre-qualification process. This process has been simplified via extensive collaboration between the Nigerian Petroleum Exchange (NipeX), the Department of Petroleum Resources (DPR) and other stakeholders. This synergy birthed the current downloadable **new product code Booklet vs appropriate DPR Permits** with latest revised & reissued July 03, 2017. In spite of NipeX Team's efforts on this simplified document, findings have established some problems in the utilisation of the document by majority of the new entrants. Therefore, this article is set to cater for the rising need to educate the teeming suppliers on necessary approach that may aid them in sailing through the pre-qualification process seamlessly with minimum hassle.

In this article, our focus shall be on the management/selection of products codes, DPR Permits and pre-registration steps of suppliers in enhancing registration on the NJQS Portal.

The primary reference document used for this discussion is the **New Nipex Product Code Booklet Vs DPR Permit.** Copy can be downloaded via <u>www.nipex-ng.com/supplier/download/New</u> Nipex Product code Booklet Vs DPR Permits.

Brief Description of the New Nipex Product Code Booklet Vs DPR Permit.

The products/services codes selection vs appropriate DPR Permits (revised & reissued July 03, 2017) has four hundred and eighty five (485) product /service codes that were grouped into four categories. Classification of products codes into four main categories, namely

Category 1: Product / Equipment / Materials supply. (117 listed services)

Category 2: Products / Equipment / Materials supply (60 listed services)

Category 3: Services (243 listed services)

Category 4: Multidiscipline / Combine supplies and or services (Turnkey / Packages) (65 listed services)

Four main columns are as shown below

Kindly note that the maximum number of product/service codes the system authorised for new entrants is twenty (20).

Five Basic supplier self-assessment questions prior to selecting products codes and NJQS registration

1. Does the Company's Memorandum and Articles of Association cover the scope of services the supplier intends to render?

2. Is the company willing and desirous to offer these services?

3. How equipped is the company with necessary resource in providing the services?

4. Is there any evidence that the company possesses additional regulatory licences that may be required for the services planned to render?

5.0 Is the company ready and willing to meet all necessary basic legal requirements for the provision of the services she intends to enlist on the NJQS Portal? Having considered the above five main preliminary self-assessment questions, if responses are affirmative, then the supplier can proceed to the next level of product code selection following the steps below.

A. Visit <u>www.nipex-ng.com</u>

B. Click on services icon on the NipeX portal

C. While on services, check download

D. Download the New NipeX Product Code Booklet Vs DPR Permit

Once equipped with the new product code booklet Vs DPR permits, the suppliers can commence the selection of the NipeX Product code that may aid them in the NJQS pre-qualification process.
