- o Provision of Vehicle Rental and Hiring Services

The following are the Nigerian Content requirements bidders are expected to comply with in their technical bid submission.

- A. Demonstrate that entity is a Nigerian registered company with greater than 51% Nigerian shareholding. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.) including company memorandum & article of association and/or evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & ownership structure in Nigeria.
- B. Tenderers shall provide evidence category 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 NCEC for Non-Move able Asset (DA) group to demonstrate capacity and capability to execute the work scope.
- C. Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- D. Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- E. Tenderer shall provide Location of in-country facilities (not limited to administrative office, automobile workshop) to execute the work scope.
