PROVISION OF HELICOPTER TRANSPORTATION SERVICES IN SUPPORT OF ITS NNPCL/CNL JOINT VENTURE AND AGBAMI DEEP WATER OPERATIONS

1. INTRODUCTION:

The following Chevron companies in Nigeria: Chevron Nigeria Limited ("CNL") operator of the Nigerian National Petroleum Company Limited (NNPCL)/CNL Joint Venture, Star Deep Water Petroleum Limited ("SDWPL"), operator of the Agbami field on behalf of its co-venturers (FAMFA Oil Limited, Equinor Nigeria Energy Company Limited, Prime 127 Nigeria Limited and NNPCL) invites interested and prequalified companies to this tender opportunity for the provision of Helicopter Transportation Services in support of its NNPCL/CNL Joint Venture and Agbami Deep Water operations. The proposed contract commencement is 4th Quarter of 2024, with a proposed term of five years (5) years with a two (2) years option to extend.

2. SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of work for the services includes, but is not limited to

- Provision of JV Helicopter Transportation Services
 - Transportation of Company and Contractor personnel and materials Provision of dedicated night standby medevac service using one of the

 - contracted aircraft and day medevac transport when required. The Provision and Operation of the Helicopters, required crew and maintenance support, shall be in line with Nigerian Civil Aviation Regulations (NCAR). and Chevron Aviation Standards' requirements.

 o Operation of the Helicopters from the Contractor's owned and operated
 - passenger handling facility at Murtala Muhammed Airport, Lagos, or an alternative facility acceptable solely at Company's discretion and from
 - Company's Escravos Base to locations required by the Company. The estimated number of flying hours per month per aircraft is 135
 - o Compliance with all Chevron Aviation Standards' requirements for aviation equipment, personnel experience and safety management requirements for operators is required.
- Provision of DW Helicopter Transportation Services.
 - Transportation of Company and Contractor personnel to specified locations from the Contractor Base in Lagos and Port Harcourt, Company Bases in Warri and Escravos and any other locations as may be required by Company.
 - The Provision and Operation of the Helicopters, required crew and maintenance support, shall be in line with Nigerian Civil Aviation
 - Regulations (NCAR) and Chevron Aviation Standards' requirements.

4. NIGERIAN CONTENT:

- Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Administrative/Technical offices, workshop etc.) in Nigeria to support this contract.
- Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- Tenderers shall provide evidence of any of the under-listed document demonstrating capacity to execute the work scope: Category 1,2,3,4 or 5 NCEC in the Non movable (DA) Asset group
- demonstrating capacity to carry out Helicopter logistics services in the Nigerian oil and Gas Industry.
- Category 1,2, or 3 Construction and Moveable equipment group NCEC demonstrating ownership of Helicopter in-country.
- Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
