Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.) including company memorandum & article of association and/or evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & ownership structure in Nigeria. Tenderer shall provide evidence of NCDMB NOGIC JQS registration.
- Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- Tenderer shall provide Location of in-country facilities (not limited to administrative office, maintenance workshop, fabrication workshop) to execute
 the work scope.
- Bidder shall provide valid Category 1,2,3, 4 or 5 of the following NCEC to execute the work scope.
 - 1. Construction and Movable equipment (EC) group demonstrating ownership of construction and maintenance equipment for repair of flowlines
 - 2. Fabrication and Construction (FC) group demonstrating ownership of fabrication equipment for Construction. Replacement, and Repair of Flowlines
