## 1. INTRODUCTION:

HEIRSHOLDINGS OIL & GAS LIMITED (hereinafter referred to as "HHOG") seeks interested and pre-qualified Contractors for Provision of Pumping and Stimulation Services in OML 17 on a call-off basis as detailed in item 2 below. The contract is proposed to commence in Q1 2023 and continue for a duration of Three (3) years with an option to extend for additional period of two (2) years.

#### 2. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

The Contractor shall provide all resources (equipment, tools, personnel, materials etc.) required to conduct all forms of pumping and stimulation activities which includes but is not limited to Nitrogen Lift, Solvent Stimulation, Acid Stimulation, Sand Clean-out, Sand Consolidation, Open Hole Gravel Pack, High-Rate Water Pack, Frac Pack, Cement Water Shut-off, Cement Squeeze-off, and cement plug setting as may be required.

Provide equipment, consumables, personnel, and back-up which shall include but not limited to:

- a) Design: Preparation of pumping and well stimulation programs, including hydraulic simulations and fluids formulations.
- b) **Provision:** Pumping and well stimulation services; Pumping and stimulation skids (or vessel), tanks and other equipment necessary to accomplish successful pumping or well stimulation operations; Environmentally friendly Fluids and chemical products necessary for pumping and well stimulation operations; Laboratory facility for verifying fluids quality; Qualified/ experienced team for preparation and job execution Specialist assistance during installation in wells
- c) Preparation: QA/QC as per preventative maintenance program acknowledged by COMPANY; Consumables QA/QC and laboratory testing as per COMPANY approved procedures; SITs and Yard Testing (pressure test, horsepower test, proppant pumping test); Equipment load-out for operations in compliance with lifting policies.
- d) Operational Support: Providing an engineering review prior to and during the well drilling/completion period; Provide daily operations reports; Real time data transmission for follow up
- e) Post job Services: Operation and procedure performance improvement reviews; Final operation reports including post job evaluation (downhole gauges pressure match, pack efficiency, etc) at the end of each well; Treatment and safe disposal of waste chemicals

# 3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

3.1. To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested Tenderers are required to be pre-qualified in the **3.04.18 – Well** 

Overhauling/Stimulation Services, (Product/Service) category in NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) database. All successfully pre-qualified Contractors in this category will receive invitations to Tender.

- 3.3 If you are not listed in this product/service category and you are registered with NUPRC, please contact NipeX office at No.8 Bayo Kuku Street, Ikoyi Lagos with your NUPRC certificate as evidence for verification and necessary update.
- 3.4 To initiate the JQS pre-qualification process, access <u>www.nipexng.com</u> to download an application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.

3.5. In addition, Tenderers shall also be required to comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development Act 2010.

## 4. NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS:

Tenderers are to note that they will be requested during the technical tender to provide details of their relevant strategy to ensure that they fully comply with the Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Act, 2010 as provided at <a href="https://www.nnpcgroup.com">www.nnpcgroup.com</a> and <a href="https://www.nigcontent.com">www.nigcontent.com</a>, in view of the fact that non-compliance will constitute a fatal flaw in all contract evaluations.

The Nigerian Content Development Monitoring Board (NCDMB) will require each Tenderer to:

- 1. Demonstrate that the entity proposed for execution of the service, is a Nigerian Registered Company, or Nigerian Registered Company as the contracting entity in genuine alliance or joint venture with foreign company with details on scope and responsibilities of parties for this work. Such companies must show evidence of joint venture binding agreement duly signed by the CEO of both companies including evidence or plans of physical operational presence and set-up in Nigeria
- Furnish details of company ownership and share holding structure. With photocopies of its CAC Forms CO2 and CO7
- Provide evidence of what percentage of its key management positions are held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. And show overall percentage of work to be performed by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- Provide a Nigerian Content Plan with detailed description of the role, work scope, man-hours and responsibilities of all the Nigerian companies and personnel that will be involved in executing the work.
- State proposed total scope of work to be conducted by Nigerian personnel (whether contracted directly or under subcontract agreements) with names and addresses including evidence of well-equipped offices and workshop.
- 6. In line with the NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative, Bidder shall commit to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution (s).
- 7. Provide evidence of domiciliation of project management and procurement centers in Nigeria with physical addresses (not P.O. Box).
- Provide detailed description of the location of in-country facilities (Equipment, storage, workshops, repair, maintenance and testing facilities
- 9. Provide detailed statement with evidence of how it intends to maximize the use of Nigerian made goods and services.
- 10. Provide evidence of registration with NCDMB NJQS.
- Bidders to provide valid NCEC Category "SS" for Service & Support Group.
- 12. Provide details on any other Nigerian Content initiative the company is involved in.
