INTRODUCTION:

HEIRS HOLDINGS OIL & GAS LIMITED (hereinafter referred to as "HHOG") seeks interested and pre-qualified Contractors for Provision of Catering & Housekeeping Services for Obigbo and Agbada Field Operating Complexes (FOC) as detailed in item 2 below. The contract is proposed to commence in Q3 2023 and continue for a duration of Two (2) years with an option to extend for an additional period of one (1) vear.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Provision of Catering and Housekeeping Services for HHOG Offices and Field Operating Complexes (FOC), which includes but not limited to the following:

Catering- 24 hours/day, 7 days/Week, 3 meals/day

- Remote cooking of meals at contractor's base facility,
- Provision of qualified, competent, and safety trained personnel
- Supply and trucking of fresh and wholesome food commodities, full plated three-course national and continental buffet canteen services and packed meals, coffee, tea, fruit juice, etc.
- Provision of desserts, confectionery, and seasonal fruits
- Provision of weekly and quarterly tea, coffee, milk, and edible consumables.
- Provision full outdoor catering services for any special event/function as may be required by HHOG.
- Mobilization of all resources including labour, equipment, cookware, and utensils necessary to deliver on-site plated catering meal services at the FOCs.
- Provision of occasional supply of meals in transportable airtight takeout/containers in accordance with safe food handing protocols to remote locations.
- Provision of portable bottled water, non-alcoholic beverages, and natural juices

Provide full housekeeping and laundry services including but not limited to:

- Daily cleaning of offices, rooms, urinals and toilets, change out of beddings and provision of Toiletries.
- Provide cleaning materials, reagents, supplies, and equipment to industry standards.
- Provide janitorial services to offices, Field Operating Complexes and designated work areas.
- Monthly deep clean spaces at offices, field operating complexes, including windows, curtains, walls, floors and ceilings, light fixtures, etc. according to schedule.
- Operate laundry and associated machinery, wash and iron employees, contractors and visitors clothing and work coverall.
- Wash, manage and distribute all bed linen (sheets, blankets, pillows, spread, towels etc.)
- Provide pest eradication services using the approved chemicals (Alpha-Cypermethrin and Lambda-Cyhalothrin).
- Provide beddings and towels for all rooms, sufficient to meet the demand of the Personal on Board (POB) per location and to accommodate visiting personnel.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

3.1. To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested Tenderers are required to be pre-qualified in the Catering and Housekeeping Services Service 3.18.03 category in NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) database. All successfully pre-qualified Contractors in this category will receive invitations to Tender.

4. NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS:

Tenderers are to note that they will be requested during the technical tender to provide details of their relevant strategy to ensure that they fully comply with the Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Act, 2010 as provided at www.nnpcgroup.com and www.nigcontent.com, in view of the fact that noncompliance will constitute a fatal flaw in all contract evaluations.

The Nigerian Content Development Monitoring Board (NCDMB) will require each Tenderer to:

- Demonstrate that the entity proposed for execution of the service, is a Nigerian Registered Company, or Nigerian Registered Company as the contracting entity in genuine alliance or joint venture with foreign company with details on scope and responsibilities of parties for this work. Such companies must show evidence of joint venture binding agreement duly signed by the CEO of both companies including evidence or plans of physical operational presence and set-up in Nigeria.
- Furnish details of company ownership and share holding structure. With photocopies of its CAC Forms CO2 and CO7
- Provide evidence of what percentage of its key management positions are held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. And show overall percentage of work to be performed by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- Provide a Nigerian Content Plan with detailed description of the role, work scope, man-hours and responsibilities of all the Nigerian companies and personnel that will be involved in executing the work.
- State proposed total scope of work to be conducted by Nigerian personnel (whether contracted directly or under subcontract agreements) with names and addresses including evidence of wellequipped offices and kitchen facility in Port Harcourt.
- Tenderer to submit a detailed training plan which shall provide sustainable training and development (including certification as applicable) for Nigerians in line with the Human Capacity Development Initiative Guideline of the Nigerian Development and Monitoring Board's (NCDMB). The training plan will include contract-specific training and estimated man-hours. Tenderer is required to submit MOA with Oil and Gas Trainers Association of Nigeria (OGTAN) trainers to support their training plan, which shall be 15% of the project Man-hours or 3% of the total contract sum.
- Provide evidence of completed registration on NCDMB NOGICD JQS portal.
- Tenderer shall provide valid Category "DA" Nigerian Content Equipment Certificate (NCEC) for (Non-movable Equipment) related to catering services).
- Provide evidence of domiciliation of project management and procurement centers in Nigeria with physical addresses (not P.O.
- Provide detailed description of the location of in-country facilities (Equipment, storage, kitchen and associated facilities
- Provide detailed statement with evidence of how it intends to maximize the use of Nigerian made goods and services.
- Provide details on any other Nigerian Content initiative the company is involved in.
