- All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in this categories will receive Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT).**
- To determine if you are pre-qualified and view the product/service category you are listed for: Open Open www.vendors.nipex-ng.com and access NJQS with your log in details, click on continue Joint Qualification Scheme tool, click check my supplier status and then clicksupplier product group.
- If you are not listed in a product/service category but you are registered with NUPRC to do business, contact NipeX office at 8, Bayo Kuku Street, Ikoyi Lagos with your NUPRC certificate as evidence for verification and necessary update.
- To initiate the NJQS pre-qualification process, access www.nipexng.com to download application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action

- To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.

4. NIGERIAN CONTENT

Bidders are invited to express complete understanding, willingness and commitment to develop in-country capability and capacity for related items in compliance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act (NOGICD Act, 2010).

Pursuant to the above, bidders' submissions shall be evaluated strictly with the minimum evaluation criteria defined in the NOGICD Act provisions and Schedule. Only bidders whose submissions are in compliance shall proceed to the next stage of the tendering process

The following are some information/documentation that will be required for submission at the ITT stage:

- Only Nigerian registered companies with 51% or greater Nigerian shareholding shall bid for this work scope. Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian company having 51% or greater Nigerian shareholding. Provide details of its Ownership Structure. Submit certified true copies of CAC form (CO2 and CO7) including Memorandum and Article of Association. Including evidence of being registered on the NCDMB NOGIC JQS.
- Nigerian Content Execution Plan with detailed description of the role, work scope, man-hours and responsibilities of all Nigerian companies and personnel that are involved in executing the service;
- Current and in-place organization structure with detailed experience and skills of key management personnel with names;
- Evidence (personnel list and positions with organization chart to substantiate) of percentage of management that are Nigerian nationals and the percentage of the total workforce that are Nigerians;
- In line with the NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative, Bidder shall Commit to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution
- Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (technical & administrative office) in Nigeria to support this contract.

NOTE: Only Nigerian Companies are qualified for this service.

- Bidders shall be requested to provide evidence to show their compliance with the above listed requirements at the ITT stage.
- Failure to meet the Nigerian Content requirements is a "FATAL FLAW."

5. CLOSING DATE

Only tenderers who are pre-qualified with the relevant NJQS product/service categories, **3.05.02 – (Electrical / Instrument Services)**, **3.05.11 – (Rotating Equipment Maintenance Services)** and **3.05.25 – (Valve Management Services including Testing and Repair)**, as at 24th July, 2023 by 1600hrs, being the advert closing date and time, shall be invited to submit Technical Bids.
