1. INTRODUCTION

Nigerian Agip Oil Company limited (NAOC) intends to issue Contract for MACHINE SHOP SERVICES on NAOC Land and Swamp Area wells, for two (2) years firm period plus one (1) year optional extension.

NAOC therefore uses this medium to inform suitable and reputable Companies having requisite experience, available equipment, consumables and resources the execution of the project of this magnitude to register or update their registration with NipeX for consdieration in the subject opportunity.

2. SCOPE OF WORK/SERVICE REQUIREMENT

- a) CONTRACTOR shall be able to provide a threads cutting and re-threading facilities equipped to perform the following activity:
- a. Tubing/Casing API and Premium connection re-threading up to 20°OD.
- b. Pup Joint re-threading up to 3 m length with OD up to 20" OD
- c. Fabrication of Lifting Nubbins and Circulating Head for all thread types.
- d. Fabrication of X-Over Subs.
- e. Supply standard alloys materials
- b) CONTRACTOR shall be
- a. licensed to API thread connections in accordance with API-5CT (EU, NU, BTC, STC, LTC)
- b. Licensed to thread Premium connections (Tenaris, Valourec, Atlas Bradford, JFE).
- c. Licensed to thread Rotary Shouldered connections and Drill String subs in accordance with API7-1.
- c) CONTRACTOR shall provide local base (located in Port Harcourt/Onne) with all facilities and personnel to support the Machine Shop Operations.
- d) CONTRACTOR local base shall be capable of storing, maintaining, inspecting, repairing and overhauling CONTRACTOR'S equipment and COMPANY tubular.
- e) CONTRACTOR shall maintain, repair and calibrate all the equipment according to a maintenance program as per CONTRACTOR QA/QC System. Such program shall be available for COMPANY's verification.
- f) CONTRACTOR shall provide all the quality control and HSE documents related to personnel and to the tools, equipment and materials.
- g) CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for QA/QC of the final product or service according to API and ISO procedures.
- h) CONTRACTOR shall implement additional work requested by COMPANY. If such additional work is not part of CONTRACTOR's price lists or catalogues, CONTRACTOR and COMPANY shall mutually agree the scope and terms under which the service is provided.

3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

4. NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENT

- i. Tenderer shall demonstrate that entity is a Nigerian-registered company with greater than 51% Nigerian shareholding as described in the NOGICD Act. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10,02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc) and other evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & ownership structure. Tenderer shall provide evidence of registration on the NCDMB NOGICJQS.
- ii. Tenderer shall provide detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (technical office and administrative office, machine shop etc) to be used in.
- iii. Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume
- iv. Tenderer shall provide category 1,2,3,4 or 5 Manufacturing Services (MS) group NCEC demonstrating ownership of machine shop to be utilized in the execution of work scope.
- v. category 1,2,3,4 or 5 Fabrication & Construction (FC) group NCEC demonstrating ownership of machine shop to be utilized in executing the work scope.
- vi. Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).

NOTE: Non-compliance with Nigerian content requirements is a FATAL FLAW
