1. INTRODUCTION

The Nigerian Agip Oil Company limited (NAOC) has a requirement to issue PERMANENT DOWNHOLE MONITORING SYSTEM contract for the Scope of Work identified below on NAOC land and swamp locations for two (2) years firm period each plus one (1) year optional extension.

NAOC therefore invites submissions for the purpose of technical evaluation from suitable and reputable companies having the capability and experience to undertake the under defined scope of work:

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The COMPANY requires the services of a specialised CONTRACTOR able to carry out the following services for the provision of Permanent Downhole Monitoring System for NAOC JV in land and swamp areas.

The Permanent downhole monitoring Service includes the following stages:

- Co-operation with completion service COMPANY to define permanent downhole gauge equipment characteristics (planning phase) in case of highly deviated well with high dog log severity in cased hole operations;
- Data acquisition and transmission
- Setting and recovering of cableless telemetry system
- Tubing installed permanent downhole gauges.
- Installation of surface facility
- Provide real time permanent downhole monitoring of reservoir condition
- Acquiring and interpreting field data;
- Preparing a final Job Report with remarks and assessment of the work carried out and an indication of whether the targets set by the program have been reached or not.

The permanent downhole monitoring application is run with or through wide range of different completion types for 2-3/8" - 7 tubing sizes in vertical, deviated and horizontal wells.

Failure to meet any of these requirements shall lead to outright disqualification.

CONTRACTOR shall conform to **ISO 9000** series International Standard. All the activities shall be carried out with minimum impact on the environment and maximum care of health and safety of all concerned, directly or indirectly, with the activities.

3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested contractors are required to be registered in the following Product/Service Categories in the NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) database:
Product Categories (3.04.17) - Well Completion permanent downhole and surface monitoring accessories and services and (3.15.04) - Well Services.

- c) If you are not listed in a product/service category but you are registered with DPR to do business, contact NipeX office at 8, Bayo Kuku Road, Ikoyi Lagos with your DPR certificate as evidence for necessary update.
- d) To initiate the JQS pre-qualification process, access www.nipex-ng.com click on services tab followed by NJQS registration.
- e) To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.

4. NIGERIAN CONTENT

Bidders are invited to express complete understanding, willingness and commitment to comply with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development (NOGICD) Act, 2010 and Insurance ACT 2003. Consequently, bidders' submissions shall be evaluated strictly with the minimum evaluation criteria defined in the NOGICD Act.

The documentation for evaluation shall include but not be limited to the following:

1. Only Nigerian companies having equal or greater than 51% Nigerian shareholding shall participate in this tender
2. Provide evidence of company Ownership Structure form CO2 and CO7, registration on NOGIC JQS and DPR certificate.
3. Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Administrative/Technical offices, workshop, assembly area, etc) in Nigeria to support this contract.
4. Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
5. Bidders shall provide evidence of Category 1,2, or 3 Service & Support group (SS) NCEC demonstrating ownership of equipment to be utilized in the execution of the work scope.
6. Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).

NOTE: Non-compliance with Nigerian content requirements is a FATAL FLAW

Only tenderers who are pre-qualified as LIVE status with NJQS in the following Product/Service Category as at **the closing date of the advert on 19th of September, 2022** at 16:00hrs shall be invited to submit Technical Bids.
