1.0 INTRODUCTION

Shell Nigeria Exploration and Production Company Limited (SNEPCo), Operator of NNPC/Shell/Elf/Agip Joint Venture hereby announces to interested companies an upcoming tendering opportunity both for the **Provision of External 3D Seismic Data Processing Services**. The proposed contract will commence in Q3 2023 and remain active for a three (3) year duration, followed by a two (2) year extension option.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The services will be performed by call-off contracts with qualified seismic processing contractors with offices in Nigeria. It is expected that qualified contractors will have the capacity and manpower to perform all processing services in Nigeria in line with the Nigerian Content requirements.

Scope of activities under this contract include:

- Processing of Deepwater seismic data through prescribed SNEPCO processing sequence from field tapes to Pre-Stack Depth Migration
- Processing of Deep Water OBN (Ocean Bottom Node) seismic data through prescribed SNEPCO processing sequence from field tapes to Pre-Stack Depth Migration
- Testing required processing parameters to ensure optimal results
- Input and output of seismic data in approved Society of Exploration Geophysicist (SEG) standard format or optionally in SIPMAP format written into standard media
- Input and output of ASCII data such as navigation or velocity data in an approved format
- Submission of closeout and final seismic data processing reports

All services will be delivered by Nigerians.

3.0 MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested contractors are required to be pre-qualified as essential service vendor in 3.10.02 (2D/3D/4D Seismic Data Processing Services) AND 3.10.08 (OBC Seismic Processing Services) product categories in NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) database. Only successfully pre-qualified suppliers in BOTH of these categories will receive Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT).
- 2. To determine if you are pre-qualified and view product/service category you are listed for, open <u>vendors.nipex-ng.com</u> and access NJQS with your login details, click on continue Joint Qualification Scheme tool, click check my supplier status and then click supplier product group.
- 3. If you are not listed in a product/service category you are registered with DPR to do business, contact NipeX office at No 8/10 Bayo Kuku Road, Ikoyi, Lagos with your DPR certificate as evidence for necessary update.
- 4. To initiate the JQS prequalification process, access <u>www.nipex-ng.com</u> to download the application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.
- 5. To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content Requirements in the NipeX system.

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4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

Vendors are to demonstrate strict compliance with the provisions of Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development Act and also provide the following requirements:

- 1. Demonstrate that entity is a Nigerian registered company. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07. Tenderer shall provide evidence of registration on NOGIC JQS and NUPRC certificate.
- 2. Tenderer shall provide Location of in-country facilities (not limited to administrative office, technical office etc.) to execute the work scope.
- 3. Tenderer shall provide evidence of Category 1,2,3,4 or 5 Services and Support (SS) group NCEC demonstrating ownership of seismic processing equipment to execute the work scope.
- 4. Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- 5. Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).

5.0 CLOSING DATE

Only Tenderers who are registered in the relevant NJQS product categories as at 23:59 hours on 04/04/2023 being the advert close date shall be invited to submit combined Technical and Commercial bids.
