 - Contingency packer setting operations
 - downhole Gauges
 - Electronic BHP/BHT surveys
 - Electronic Downhole Tools shut-in tools operations
 - Permanent or Temporary Plugs setting and pulling
 - Leak investigations TRSSV lockouts
 - Sand Bailing and Kinley Calliper Services
 - Fishing
 - Servicing of Sub Surface Flow Contract Equipment
 - Upfront Slickline operations – drift run, HUD investigation etc.
 - Specialized and emerging Slickline services
- Competent and qualified personnel to execute the Slickline services;

Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.) including company memorandum & article of association and/or evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & ownership structure in Nigeria.
- Tenderer shall provide evidence of registration with the NCDMB NOGIC JQS and NUPRC
- Tenderers shall provide evidence category 1, 2, 3 or 4 NCEC for Services and Support (SS) group NCEC to demonstrate ownership slickline equipment to execute the work scope.
- Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- Tenderer shall provide Location of in-country facilities (not limited to administrative office) to execute the work scope.
