- Telephone Switchboard operations service in Lagos office
- Procurement of spares
- Logistics; Lease of operational vehicles
- Provision of return repair services,
- Cable Network capacity management

4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

Vendors are to demonstrate strict compliance with the provisions of Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development Act and also provide the following requirements:

- I. Tenderer shall provide evidence of company Ownership Structure form CO2 and CO7, registration on NOGIC JQS and DPR certificate.
- II. Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Administrative/Technical offices) in Nigeria to support this contract
- III. In line with the latest NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative, Tenderer shall commit to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- IV. Provide evidence of category 1, 2,3, 4 or 5 Production Services (SS) NECE.
- V. Tenderer shall provide evidence of Nigerian Communications Commission's (NCC) permit/license
- VI. Tenderer shall provide evidence of OEM representation letter and or MOA with the OEM to execute the work scope
- VII. Provide evidence of Nigerian personnel that shall execute the work scope, stating positions that are Management and other personnel.
