## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

SPDC is seeking for interested and qualified Telecoms service Providers for Telecommunication Cabling Systems Network Upgrade. SPDC has a large telecoms cable network covering office locations, residential locations, field logistics bases, rigs sites etc. SPDC invites submission from reputable Nigerian registered companies having professional experience in Provision of Structured Office and Fibre Optic Cabling.

The proposed contract will provisionally commence in Q2 2022 and remain active for 2 years' duration, followed by 1-year extension option. Two contracts are planned for award.

#### 2.0 SCOPE OF WORK/SERVICE REQUIREMENT

The scope of work for the services shall include but not limited to:

- Inspections and survey of existing cabling network infrastructure
  Design of new/additional Structured Office/Campus Cabling infrastructure,
- Design of new/additional Structured Office/Campus Cabling infrastructure, inter-location/Campus Optic Fibre system networks, and CATV systems and network infrastructure

# 4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

Vendors are to demonstrate strict compliance with the provisions of Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development Act and provide the following requirements:

- Demonstrate that entity is a Nigerian registered company. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.) including company memorandum & article of association and/or evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & ownership structure in Nigeria
- II. Tenderers shall provide evidence category 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 NCEC for Construction and Movable Equipment (EC) demonstrating capacity and capability to execute the work scope
- III. Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- IV. Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- V. Tenderer shall provide evidence of Location of in-country facilities (not limited to administrative office) to execute the work scope.
